- THE SAFE-T-STRAP IS A COMPONENT OF A FALL-ARREST SYSTEM. LOCATION OF INDIVIDUAL STRAPS WILL VARY AND SPECIFIC PROCEDURES FOR INSTALLATION WILL BE REQUIRED TO ENSURE ADEQUATE FALL PROTECTION FOR WORKERS.

NOTE: AFTER CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETE, ALL REMAINING EXPOSED SAFE-T-STRAPS SHOULD BE REMOVED.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- THE RESIDENTIAL CHOKER STRAP CONSISTS OF A FLAT LOOP AT EACH END OR A FLAT LOOP ON ONE END AND A D-RING ON THE OTHER. THE END WITH OPTIONAL D-RING HAS A LABEL SEWN IN AND THE OTHER IS JUST A LOOP.
- THE SMALLER LOOP IS CHOKED THROUGH THE LABELLED LOOP AROUND THE TOP PLATES OF THE WALL (FIGURE 1) OR TRUSS (FIGURE 2). A MINIMUM 3" NAIL IS THE HAMMERED THROUGH THE STITCHED AREA TO ENSURE ANCHOR IS FIRMLY IN PLACE. IN THE CASE OF 2X4 TRUSS THE NAIL IS PLACED IN STITCHED AREA THROUGH THE 4" PORTION OF THE TOP CORD.
- IN A RETRO-FIT APPLICATION THE NAIL MAY BE OMITTED. THE RESIDENTIAL SAFE-T-STRAPS ARE DESIGNED FOR SINGLE USE ONLY. EACH STRAP MUST BE INSPECTED BY A COMPETENT WORKER BEFORE EACH USE.

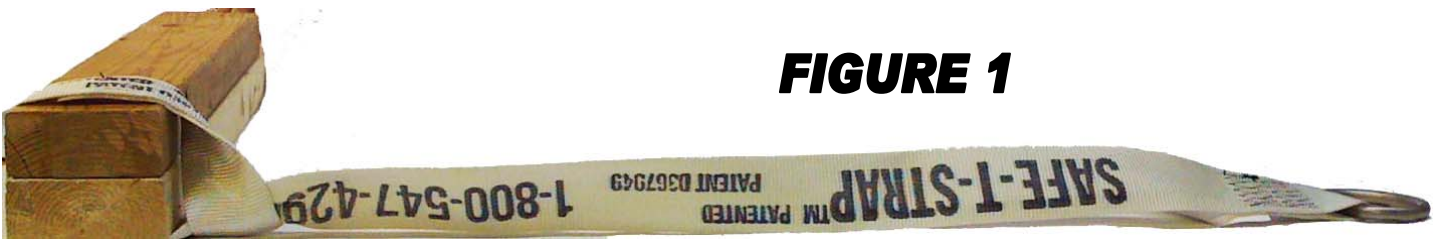
